

## **American University Neighborhood Partnership Steering Committee Summary**

Summary: The January steering committee meeting began with a welcome from the new neighborhood co-chair Jerry Gallucci, as well as Seth Grossman, from American University. Next, the co-chairs of the transportation and parking, student life and safety and facilities planning working groups updated the committee on the work done since the last meeting occurred in September. Following discussion from members of the group, Gwen Coleman reviewed the campus plan compliance matrix featuring the required conditions as set forth by the Zoning Commission. The meeting closed out with Seth briefing the group on AU's relationships with neighboring properties such as the DHS building and Wesley Seminary, Jerry also discussed several of his priorities for the Neighborhood Partnership in 2024 noting that he and Seth both agreed that the Partnership appears at an inflection point.
