Findings

Appeal

A preponderance of evidence standard is applied to determine a finding. If found responsible, a recommendation is provided to the Dean of Students, or designee, who then renders the decision to the respondent. Possible sanctions include removal from housing, suspension, and expulsion.

Appeals must be received within 7 business days after the notification outcome. Grounds for appeal: new information, insufficient/excessive sanctions, and/or procedural error.

Resolution via Disciplinary Hearing

Resolved with a panel of 3 (2 faculty/staff) and 1 student. Respondents are provided with written notice of all charges, reasonable access to the case file, an opportunity to respond, and an opportunity to provide witness statements. An advisor may be present.

Conduct Charges Filed

Alleged violation(s) of Student Conduct Code, Typically filed within 30 business days



< 21 DAYS

Disciplinary hearings are typically resolved less than 21 days 3:1

Respondents meet with 3 Conduct Council Members during the hearing

Disciplinary hearings address serious conduct violations
