

## **Timeline for Disciplinary**

## Hearing-Level Conference

04 Appeal

Appeals must be received within 7 business days after the notification outcome. Grounds for appeal: new information, insufficient/excessive sanctions, and/or procedural error.

03

Findings

A preponderance of evidence standard is applied to determine a finding. If found responsible, a recommendation is provided to the Dean of Students, or designee, who then renders the decision to the respondent. Possible sanctions include removal from housing, suspension, and expulsion.

02

Resolution via Disciplinary Hearing-Level Conference

Resolved with one Disciplinary Hearing Officer. Respondents are provided with written notice of all charges, reasonable access to the case file, an opportunity to respond, and an opportunity to provide witness statements. An advisor may be present.

01

Conduct Charges Filed

Alleged violation(s) of Student Conduct Code, Typically filed within 30 business days



< 10 DAYS

Disciplinary hearing-level conferences are typically resolved less than disciplinary hearings 1:1

Respondents meet 1:1 with an OSARP staff member

Disciplinary hearing-level conferences address serious conduct violations
